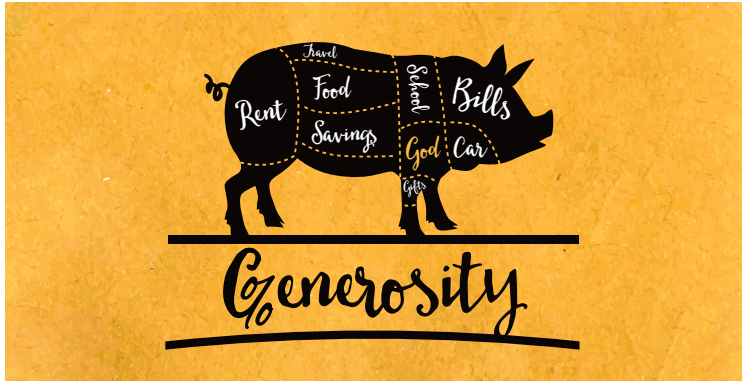


What's Happening

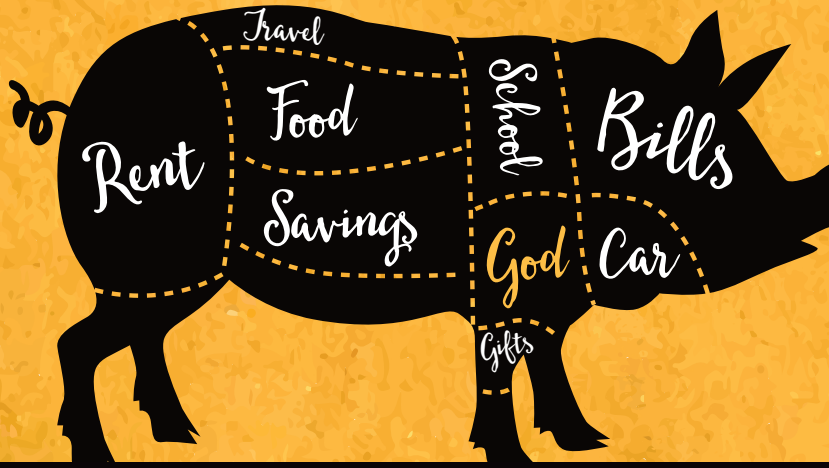
